Golf Cart Registration / Driving Rules

There are a number of owners who have not paid their \$10 golf cart registration fee, which was due on June 1st, 2009. This registration fee was set up by the ownership committee, and is required to drive golf carts on the resort property. Any owner who has not registered their golf cart has until September 7th to do so or they will have all scan cards associated with their membership—including family usage members—deactivated. Continued non-payment will result in further action, not limited to the non-renewal of your seasonal site. Again, this was implemented by the ownership committee, along with rules of usage for golf carts. These rules are posted in the reservation office.

Seasonal Sites

Effective January 1st, 2010, anyone interested in a seasonal site must fill out another interest slip in the office or on our website. This will be done on a yearly basis, with the list being posted in the office so that all members will know where they are on the seasonal site waiting list. Hopefully, this eliminate any and all confusion on this matter.
